

Dear Parents and Guardians:

In accordance with Parents Right to Know requirement under Every Student Succeeds Act ESSA, Section 1112 (e)(1)(A) this is a notification from Afton Public Schools to every parent/guardian of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive in a timely manner:

a) Information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers. The information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers shall include the following: If the teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught; If the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which the state qualifications and licensing criteria are waived; The teachers baccalaureate degree major, graduate certification, and field of discipline; and Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications [ESSA, Section 1112(e)(1)(A)(i)(ii)]

b) Information regarding any State or local educational agency policy regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by section 1111(b)(2) and by the State or local educational agency, which shall include a policy, procedure, or parental right to opt the child out of such assessment, where applicable. [ESSA, Section 1112 (e)(2)(A)]

c) upon request, parents of an English learner may: have the child immediately removed from an English Learner (EL) program; [ESSA 1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(i)] decline the child's enrollment in an EL program, or choose another program or method of instruction, if available; [ESSA, Section 1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(ii)] receive assistance in selecting among various programs and methods of instruction, if more than 1 program or method is offered by the eligible entity. [ESSA 1112(e)(3)(A)(viii)(iii)]

d) In addition to the above information you will be notified if your student has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the applicable state certification for licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned. [ESSA, Section 1112 (e)(1)(B)(ii)]



Queridos padres y guardianes:

De acuerdo con el Derecho de los Padres a requerimiento de información en el marco Cada estudiante tenga éxito Ley de ESSA, Section 1112 (e) (1) (A) Públicas de Comercio a cada padre / tutor de un estudiante en una escuela de Título I que tiene la derecho a solicitar y recibir de manera oportuna:

a) La información sobre las calificaciones profesionales de los maestros de su hijo. La información sobre las calificaciones profesionales de los maestros de su hijo incluirá lo siguiente: Si el maestro ha cumplido con requisitos estatales y los criterios de concesión de licencias para las áreas de nivel de grado y materias que se imparten; Si el maestro está enseñando bajo estado de emergencia o temporal en el que se renuncia a los requisitos estatales y los criterios de concesión de licencias; Los maestros de bachillerato grado, certificado de graduación, y el campo de disciplina; y si el estudiante recibe servicios de paraprofesionales, y si es así, sus calificaciones [ESSA, Section 1112 (e) (1) (A) (i) (ii)]

b) Información relativa a todo Estado o política de la agencia local de educación respecto a la participación de los estudiantes en cualquier evaluación requerida por la sección 1111 (b) (2) y por el Estado o la agencia local de educación, que deberá incluir una política, procedimiento o derecho de los padres a optar por la fuera hijo de dicha evaluación, en su caso. [ESSA, Section 1112 (e) (2) (A)]

c) previa solicitud, los padres de un estudiante de Inglés pueden: que el niño eliminado inmediatamente de un programa de Estudiantes de Inglés (EL); [1112 ESSA (e) (3) (A) (viii) (i)] rechaza la inscripción del niño en un programa de EL, o elegir otro programa o método de instrucción, si está disponible; [ESSA, Sección 1112 (e) (3) (A) (viii) (ii)] recibir ayuda para seleccionar entre varios programas y métodos de instrucción, si hay más de 1 programa o método es ofrecido por la entidad elegible. [ESSA 1112 (e) (3) (A) (viii) (iii)]

d) Además de la información anterior se le notificará si su estudiante ha sido enseñado por cuatro o más consecutivos semanas por un maestro que no cumple con la certificación estatal pertinente para los requisitos de certificación en el área de estudio y grado en el que el maestro tiene ha asignado. [ESSA, Section 1112 (e) (1) (B) (ii)]
