McKinney-Vento Act Residency (Homeless Student)

When families and students find themselves in transition due to their housing situation, it is important that they know their rights. Afton Public School is required to provide educational and other services to students who are homeless within our community.

- Students may attend their school of origin or the school where they are temporarily residing
- Students will be provided a written statement of their rights when they enroll.
- Students may enroll without school, medical or similar records
- Students have a right to transportation to school within the District
- Any student denied enrollment will be provided a statement outlining the reasons for the denial,

Students living in the following situations are considered homeless:

- Doubled up with family or friends due to loss of housing or economic hardship
- Living in motels and hotels for lack of other suitable housing
- · Runaway or Unaccompanied Youth
- · Homeless and domestic violence shelters
- The streets, abandoned buildings or public places not meant for housing
- Cars, trailers (excluding mobile homes) or campgrounds
- · Any housing not fit to be inhabited

Note: According to Federal Law, any information regarding any student who meets the guidelines and is enrolled as a homeless student at Afton Public School is confidential.
